Year 1 EMG Course

Year 1 EMG course will require a significant commitment of module work each week due to the nature of the advanced curriculum.

English lesson will focus on reading skills and practising spelling, vocabulary, comprehension and sentence writing skills. Mathematics lesson will be involved with various maths topics to make them understand mathematical theories and principles. General Ability lesson will cover basic concepts of verbal reasoning skills.

The course will be delivered in both way – ‘Standard EMG course’ in a normal face-to-face learning only. Students can choose the course option according to their needs and learning style.

Cyberschool services for Year 1 EMG

Cyberschool (www.cyberschool.com.au) provides the extensive revision services to help students revise their entire WEMG work during the course period. Please utilise the following Cyberschool services and maximise your learning outcome. Please note that each service is open for the specific period.

Module Answers (Weekly)

Each week's module answers are uploaded on Saturday and available until the last day of the next school holiday. You can download them under 'Material' menu at the top navigation bar. Please use the module answers after you made the first attempt to finish your module questions.

Video Lessons (Weekly)

Every question in the main textbook is explained audibly in the video lessons. Click 'Video Lesson' menu at the top navigation bar and watch the lessons to review recent modules and reinforce concepts. Please note that each video lesson is available for the next three (3) weeks from Saturday.

S.O.Q (Fortnightly)

The S.O.Q (Special Online Quiz) is a series of quiz to measure students' understanding of the previous modules in English, maths and general ability. Go to S.O.Q under 'My Test' menu at the top navigation bar. Four (4) quizzes open in Week 2, 4, 6 and 8 of the term. Each subject contains 10 questions. It will be available until the end of the term.

Vocabulary Test (Weekly)

Cyberschool is offering the weekly vocabulary test until the end of the term. To take the test, click 'My Test' menu at the navigation bar and

go to 'Online Test' page. Click on 'Vocabulary Test' tab. Strong vocabulary skill is critical as it improves all areas of communication, leading to high scores in reading and writing tests.

Term Progress Test (Week 8)

Students take the term test during Week 8 for assessment and subsequent reporting. To take the test, log in to Cyberschool during the test window, click the 'My Test' menu at the navigation bar, and go to the 'Term Progress Test' page.

Term Test Review (Weeks 10–11)

Cyberschool provides access to the 'Test Review' service during Weeks 10–11. Students can revise the English, Maths, and General Ability (G.A.) term test questions they answered incorrectly to build a solid foundation before the next term.
